

## Altered Coaster

1. Cut chipboard to 5 x 5 inches square then round the corners
2. Cut solid cardstock to fit chipboard
3. Cut three pieces of pattern paper in the following sizes (1/2 x 5 in.) (3 x 5 in.) (1 3/8 x 5 in.)
4. Attach to solid cardstock leaving an 1/8<sup>th</sup> inch space between pattern pieces
5. Using the zig zag stitch on your sewing machine sew between pattern pieces
6. Using a stamp set, stamp image onto solid cardstock and cut out
7. Attach right side of stamped image to coaster (this way you can slide your photo underneath)
8. Attach photo
9. Tie ribbon around coaster
10. Place embellishments underneath the bow and on top of stamped image. You could use some of the sequins from the April kit, flowers from the Punjab Add-on, or the rub-ons from the Maharashtra Add-on. I chose some flowers I had on hand.
11. Apply rub-on, hand written, or printed monogram initials onto jewelry tag from January kit and tie to knot portion of bow
12. Add a second motif:
  - a. Paint chipboard and apply on a Chatterbox rub-on and cut out, or
  - b. Use a chipboard motif (I chose one from Maya Road), paint, add a crackling medium and then a complimentary color (allow to dry between each step)
13. Attach sequins, rhinestones or other shiny embellishment



You can place a magnet on the back or have it sit on an easel to display.
